Dear Peter,

It's nice to hear from you.

Manfred is a great partner and friend. I really appreciate he forward to you our purpose to promote a Friendship Exchange between our districts.

Let's start from the beginning. We started RFE 7 years ago.

We hosted in 2004 a team from District 5080 (Washington State and, USA and British Columbia State, Canada). It was 8 Rotarian couples, they has hosted in our district for two weeks. 6 years ago we traveled to their district with 8 Rotarian couples. Since there we have such wonderful experiences in Australia and Mexico. Now we would like to have in Europe.

How it works?

Brazilian group, normally composed by Rotarians travel to Europe by their expenses.

The final destination is decided by the host District. In your case, for example you can chose Stuttgart for example.

How big is the group?

We are thinking about 6 couples (12 people), all of them at least one couple member has to be Rotarian. In this group we are organizing among the 12, 9 are Rotarians.

How long is the hosting?

Brazilian group would like to arrive there in April 29th, till May 11th. In total the period is 12 days.

How is the financial responsibility for the German Rotarians?

Each German family host in his home one Rotarian couple. Inside home all the expenses will be paid by the German, when they go outside (restaurant for example) each couple pay your own bill.

It will be the same here in Brazil when the German will visit us.

When the German will come?

It's up to you. The period will be the same size 12days.

We are able to host the Germans when you decide, even before April.

What about the couple?

Claudio (54) and Maria Auxiliadora Pimentel (54)

Both are Rotarians, He is doctor psychologist and she works at the clinic organizing the administration of their business

Mauricio (59) and Silvia Castro (57)

Both are Rotarians. He is Civil Engineer, specialization in meteorology and she owns a restaurant.

Gilberto (50) e Viviane Xavier (48)

Both are Rotarians. They Own a Chemistry company, producing material for home cleaning like soap, detergent and things like that.

Edson (64) and Lucia Helena Pereira (60)

Both are Rotarians. He is civil engineer, but now retired

José Roberto (57) and Rosana Pinheiro (54)

He is Rotarian, they own a magazine distribution company.

Alonso (54) and Vania Campoi (52)

He is Rotarian and PDG 06/07. He use to work as civil engineer, she use to work arts teacher, but both today owns a travel agency.
